What Is Tithes And Offering?

Tithing is giving a tenth of your increase and or substance to God. Typically, churches are the designated recipients of tithes. People give donations, usually in the form of money, for their tithes and offerings.

The first account in the Bible for tithing is when Abraham gave a tenth of his goods to Melchizedek, the king of Salem, also the High Priest of God (Gen. 14:20).

Deuteronomy 14:22 tells us God commanded the Israelites to tithe.

During this time, the Levites, represented the office of the priest, received the first fruits (Deut. 14:29).

The tithes are The Lord's, therefore it is "holy" (Lev. 27:30-33).

What Does The Bible Say About Giving?

The Bible mentioned we're blessed when we are obedient to giving. In Malachi, it specifically tells that the windows of heaven will open up and God will rebuke the enemy. It also warns that withholding what's due to God brings a curse (Malachi 3:8-12).

The tithes and offerings are God's; do not take what is holy and give to dogs (Matt. 7:6). Please do not take your tithes and offering and buy other things or pay bills.
